

We are currently conducting research on otter, and at the moment have one surplus adult male. This animal was captured by our research team on trap line #2361 under the authority of collection license #1732. We have coordinated past release of otter with Eldon Bruns (Rocky Mountain House), and would like to do the same with this otter. There is a possibility we may have a few more otter for release this spring. All animals scheduled for release are in good health and have been held with minimal human contact. I am contacting you via e-mail as opposed to a formal request by letter because we would like to release this otter as soon as possible due to stress related problems with otter in captivity.
